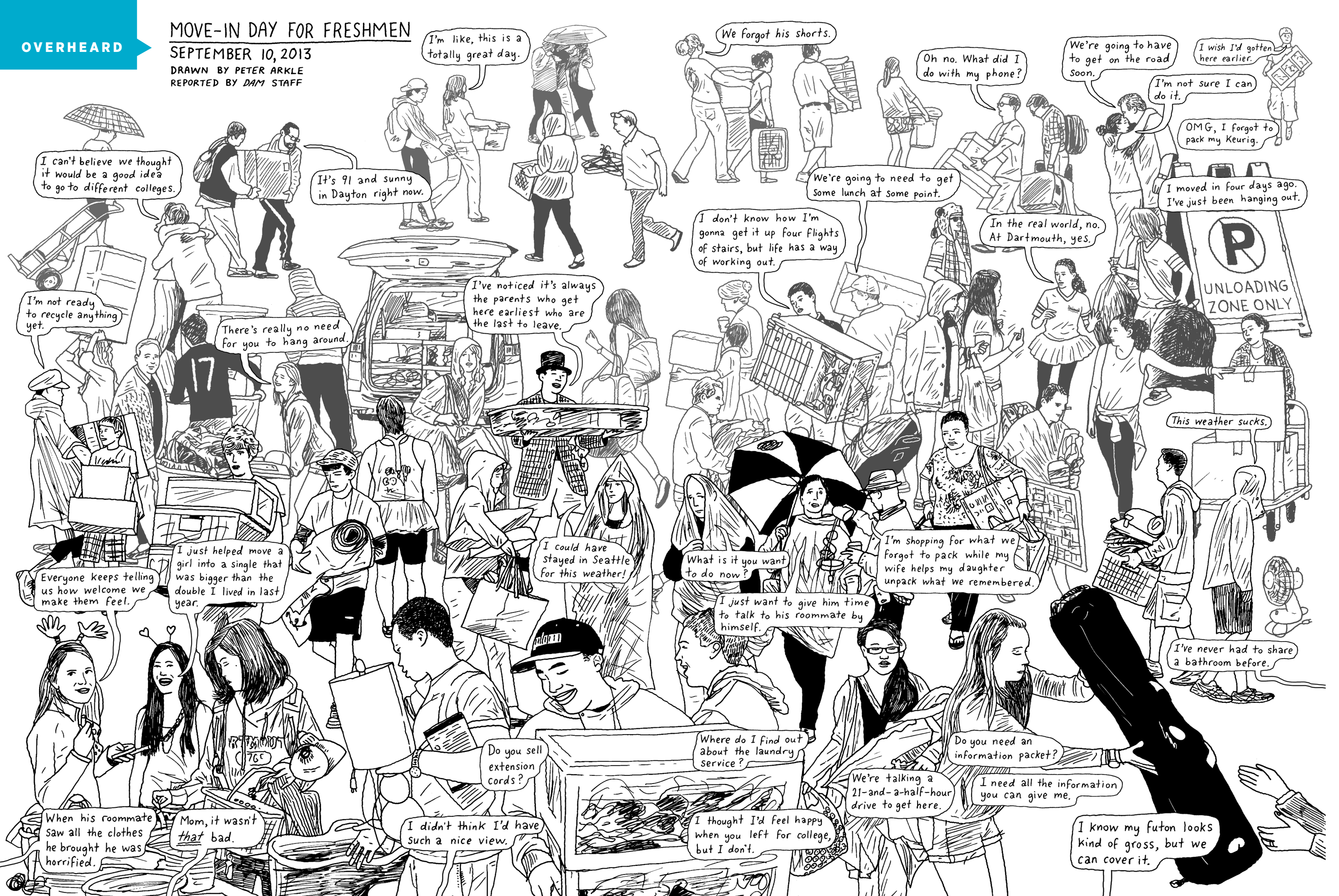


MOVE-IN DAY FOR FRESHMEN
