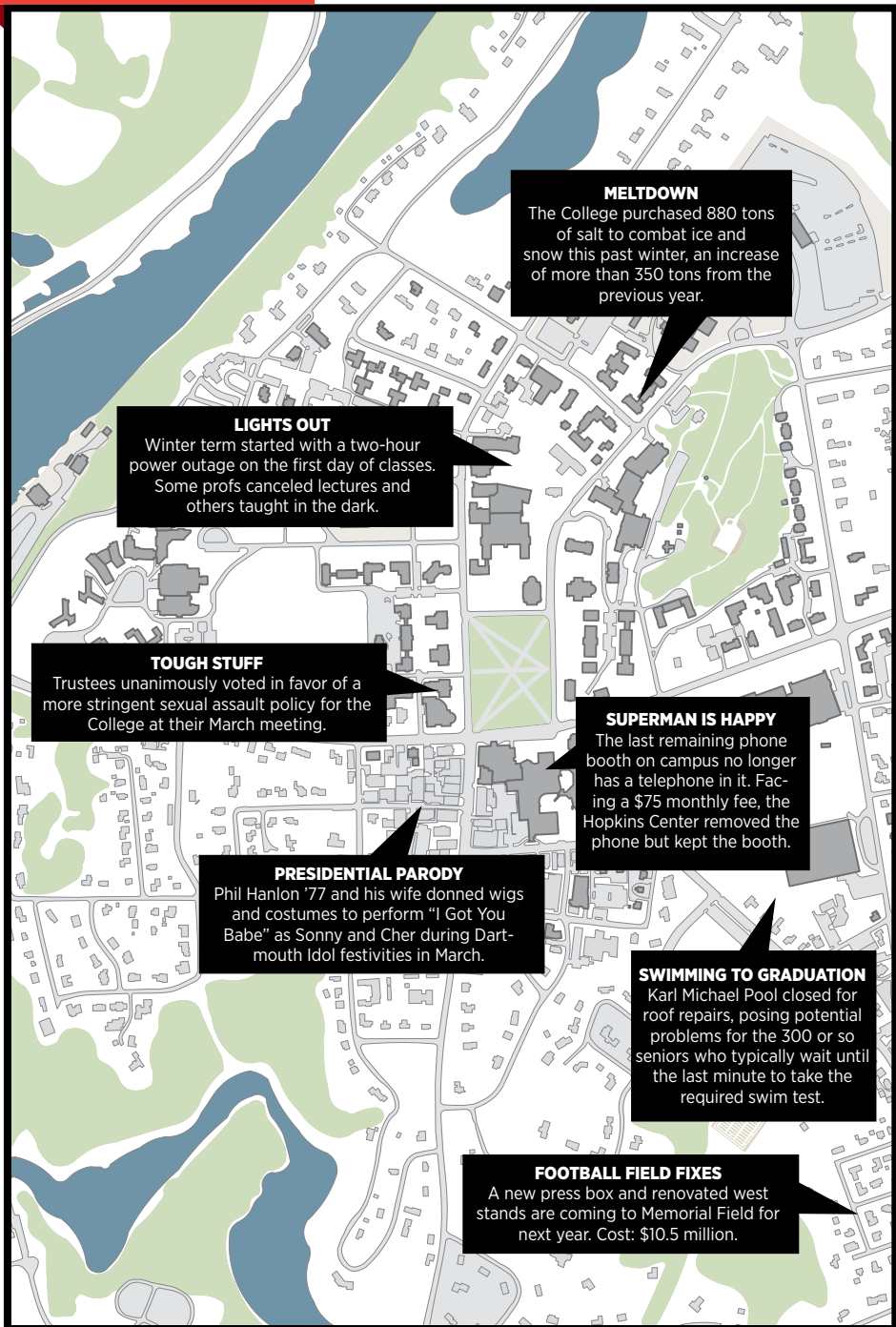


## CAMPUS CONFIDENTIAL
